- Some of your branches may be big enough to be cut into strips and put aside for use in your wood burning stove



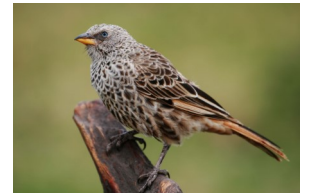
once the weather turns colder.
